Guidelines for International Arrivals – For all travellers coming/transiting through flights originating from UK,





Europe & Middle East All international travellers to submit Self-Declaration Form (SDF) online at www.newdelhiairport.in before the scheduled travel and will be required to declare their travel history (of past 14 days).

- Whether they plan to disembark at the arrival airport or take further flights to reach their final destination in India.
- The passengers will need to display this receipt to State authority / Government officials at the airport for segregation.

All the passengers to carry negative RT-PCR Test report, conducted within 72 hours prior to undertaking the journey.

- The same also shall be uploaded on the online portal (www.newdelhiairport.in).

All passengers subjected to self - paid confirmatory molecular tests on arrival at the Indian airports concerned (port of entry)

Transit passengers who tested negative, to be allowed to take their connecting flights and to remain in home quarantine for 7 days & regularly followed up by the concerned State/District IDSP.

Travellers to give a sample at the designated area and exit the airport only after confirmation of negative test report.

All other travellers from Europe and Middle East (other than those from Brazil, South Africa and United Kingdom) to give a sample at the designated area and exit the airport)

- If the test report is negative, they will be advised to self-monitor their health for 14 days.
- If the test report is positive, they will undergo treatment as per standard health protocol.
