

## **Latest Travel Advisory for International Passengers - Before Travel**

As per the latest Govt. advisory for international passengers, the following are the guidelines.

(Before travel)

1. All passengers should submit a self-declaration on the online portal [www.newdelhiairport.in](http://www.newdelhiairport.in) (72 hours prior departure)
2. Submit an online undertaking on the portal declaring to undergo mandatory quarantine for 14 days (7 days institutional at their cost + 7 days home isolation)
3. Exceptional cases (pregnancy, death in family, serious illness or traveling with children below 10 years) can claim exemption from 7 days institutional quarantine by applying on the online portal 72 hours prior to their departure. In all these cases 14 day home quarantine may be permitted.
4. Exemption from institutional quarantine can also be obtained by submitting negative (RT-PCR) report (not older than 96 hours) before departure. Should be uploaded on portal for consideration or submitted at the arrivals. Please note, the final decision confirming exemption, lies with the government.

Thermal screening (upon boarding and arrival) and Aarogya Setu app are mandatory for all the travellers.

Note : The online portal [www.newdelhiairport.in](http://www.newdelhiairport.in) is common for all airports across India.

These will be operational from 0001 hours, 8th Aug 2020
