OFFICE MEMORANDUM


Subject: Recommencement of Domestic air travel w.e.f. 25.05.2020- Updation of guidelines- reg.

Ministry of Civil Aviation vide Order of even Number dated 21.05.2020 has issued general instructions, detailed guidelines and Specific Operating Guidelines (SOP) for stakeholders, in connection with the recommencement of domestic air travel from 25th May, 2020.

2. As per Para. 1(j)(v) of Annexure-II to Order dated 21.05.2020, the passengers have to give a declaration to the effect that they have not tested COVID-19 positive in **last two months**.

3. With regard to evolving COVID-19 situation, where new cases that have been cured are in large numbers, a need has been felt to update this provision to avoid hardships in the matter of air travel to the persons cured/recovered from COVID-19.

4. It has accordingly been decided to update the above provision with the clause "I/we have not tested COVID -19 positive in the **last three weeks** (COVID-19 recovered persons fulfilling this condition will be allowed to travel upon showing a COVID-19 recovered/discharged certificate from any institution dealing with COVID-19 subjects)".
