

State-wise Quarantine Guidelines

Domestic

Institutional quarantine: No quarantine

Home quarantine: No quarantine

Health screening: Thermal screening will be done for all passengers on arrival

Covid test: Passengers travelling to the State of Punjab by air must mandatorily carry a Certificate of full/final Vaccination (both doses), OR, Carry a Negative RT-PCR certificate of the last 72 hours. Further, infants and children below 10 years of age shall be exempted from the above requirement.

Passenger obligation:

- Passengers travelling to the State of Punjab by air must mandatorily carry a Certificate of full/final Vaccination (both doses), OR, Carry a Negative RT-PCR certificate of the last 72 hours. Further, infants and children below 10 years of age shall be exempted from the above requirement.
- All travellers planning a journey shall submit a self declaration form on Air Suvudha portal.
- All incoming passengers belonging to Punjab/whose destination is Punjab shall install COVA-application on their smartphone before exiting the airport. Passengers shall necessarily turn on blue-tooth and GPS.

Airline obligation:

- Passengers travelling to the State of Punjab by air must mandatorily carry a Certificate of full/final Vaccination (both doses), OR, Carry a Negative RT-PCR certificate of the last 72 hours. Further, infants and children below 10 years of age shall be exempted from the above requirement.
- Station Managers of airlines shall give wide publicity of above instructions and ensure that pax who do not meet above requirements are not allowed to board at the points of origin itself.

Airport or State obligation

- Passengers travelling to the State of Punjab by air must mandatorily carry a Certificate of full/final Vaccination (both doses), OR, Carry a Negative RT-PCR certificate of the last 72 hours. Further, infants and children below 10 years of age shall be exempted from the above requirement.
- The passengers found to be symptomatic during screening shall be isolated and immediately action shall be taken as per health protocol.

International

Institutional quarantine: No Institutional Quarantine

Home quarantine:

All passengers shall give samples for Covid-19 testing at the designated area and exit the airport. If the test report is negative, they are advised to self monitor their health for 14 days. If test results are positive, they will undergo treatment as per standard health protocol.

Health screening: Thermal screening of all passengers.

Covid test:

- Transiting Travellers(T on SDF) travelling from Brazil, South Africa, and the United Kingdom shall give samples at designated areas and take connecting flights only after an approved negative test report.
- All other passengers shall give samples for Covid-19 testing at the designated area and exit the airport. If the test report is negative, they are advised to self monitor their health for 14 days. If test results are positive, they will undergo treatment as per standard health protocol.

Passenger obligation:

All travellers planning a journey shall submit a self declaration form on Air Suvudha portal and upload a negative RT-PCR test report with a test conducted within 72 hours prior to undertaking the journey.

Airline obligation: N/A

Airport or State obligation:

- On arrival thermal screening is carried out for all passengers and a Self Declaration Form is checked by health officials at the airport.
- Passengers found to be symptomatic during screening shall be isolated immediately and taken to the medical facility as per protocol
