Gujarat



Domestic

Institutional quarantine

Ahmedabad, Bhuj, Bhavnagar, Jamnagar, Kandla, Porbandar, Rajkot, Vadodara, Surat- Not applicable

Home quarantine

Ahmedabad, Bhuj, Bhavnagar, Jamnagar, Kandla, Rajkot, Vadodara - Not applicable

Porbandar- Passengers who are asymptomatic and entering Gujarat will not be quarantined, however they will be permitted to go with the advice that they will self-monitor their health for 14 days.
Surat- 07 days mandatory home quarantine for all passengers and to monitor their health for 14 days.

Health screening

Ahmedabad, Bhuj, Bhavnagar, Jamnagar, Kandla, Porbandar, Rajkot, Surat, Vadodara - Thermal screening shall be done for all passengers.

Covid test

● **Ahmedabad, Bhuj, Bhavnagar, Jamnagar, Porbandar, Rajkot, Kandla, Vadodara-** As per directives issued by Additional Director (Public Health), Govt. of Gujarat Notification dated 8-5-2021, the need for RT-PCR test in healthy individuals undertaking inter state domestic travel is completely removed.

● **Surat-** As per Surat Municipal Corporation, all passengers arriving from other state to Surat are required to carry 72 hours prior RT-PCR Negative test report from ICMR accredited laboratory (RT-PCR timeline is counted from swab collection) Passengers who are not carrying negative RT-PCR test report are tested by Surat Municipal Corporation(SMC).

Exemption- Fully vaccinated passengers may be exempted from carrying Negative RT-PCR Test report while arriving in Surat City

Passenger obligation

● **Ahmedabad, Bhuj, Bhavnagar, Jamnagar, Kandla, Porbandar, Rajkot, Vadodara** - All Departing passengers must have Aarogya Setu app or fill self Declaration form and must follow COVID appropriate behaviour.

● **Surat** - Passengers arriving Surat from other states have to fill online Novel Corona self reporting form and to download SMC Covid-19 Tracker app by any of the links provided .

Passengers who are found to be symptomatic during screening have to undergo Rapid Antigen Test.

Airline obligation

Ahmedabad, Jamnagar, Kandla, Porbandar, Rajkot, Vadodara - Ensure availability of arriving passenger data to State Health Officer. Airlines to ensure that passenger is carrying RT-PCR Negative test report prior departure as per the respective state health protocols.

Bhuj: Airlines shall check for Covid negative test report/Full Vaccination Certificate prior to check-in/boarding and passengers are allowed to Board only when they possess the same.

Surat- Airlines have to ensure that all passengers fill online self declaration form on SMC website prior to arrival at Surat airport.

Airport or State obligation

Ahmedabad, Bhuj, Bhavnagar, Jamnagar, Kandla, Porbandar, Vadodara- Thermal Screening shall be done for all passengers.

Surat- Rapid Antigen test of randomly selected passengers and willing passengers will be done by SMC medical team at Surat airport. Passengers who are tested positive in test will be isolated and sent for treatment.

International

Institutional quarantine

Ahmedabad, Surat- Not Applicable

Home quarantine

Ahmedabad - All travellers arriving from UK, Brazil and South Africa , if tested negative will remain home quarantine for 7 days and will be regularly followed up by the concerned State/District IDSP. These travellers shall again be tested after 7 days and if tested negative, will be released from quarantine, and continue to monitor their health for further 7 days

Surat - 07 days mandatory home quarantine for all passengers and to monitor their health for 14 days.

Health screening

Ahmedabad, Surat - Thermal screening shall be done for all passengers.

Covid test

Ahmedabad, Surat- RT-PCR test will be done at the airport mandatorily for all international travellers coming/transiting through flights originating from the United Kingdom, Europe and the Middle East. The cost of the test to be borne by the passengers.

Passenger obligation

Ahmedabad, Surat - (i) Submit a self-declaration form on the online Air Suvidha portal. (www.newdelhiaairport.in) before the scheduled travel.

(ii) Upload a negative COVID-19 RT-PCR report. This test should have been conducted within 72 hrs prior to undertaking the journey.

Airline obligation

Ahmedabad, Surat - (1) Airlines to allow boarding only to those passengers who have filled in the Self Declaration Form on the Air Suvidha portal and uploaded the negative RT-PCR test report.

(2) All passengers shall be advised to download the Aarogya Setu app on their mobile devices.

(3) During boarding all possible measures to ensure physical distancing are to be ensured.

Airport or State obligation

Ahmedabad, Surat - Symptomatic passenger will be taken to the Isolation room and further for covid test by State Authorities. RT-PCR test to be conducted at the airport for all international travellers coming/transiting through flights originating from the United Kingdom, Europe and the Middle East.
