STATE-WISE COVID-19 GUIDELINES

Punjab

(Amritsar, Pathankot, Ludhiana, Adampur)

Domestic

• Only passengers who are fully vaccinated, or Covid recovered, or with negative RTPCR report of last 72 hours shall be allowed entry in Punjab. In case a passenger doesn't have either of these, RAT testing shall be mandatory. Passengers travelling by flights shall be mandatorily required to be fully vaccinated, or Covid recovered, or with negative RTPCR report of last 72 hrs.

Institutional quarantine: N/A Home quarantine:

• Passengers who have attended large gatherings anywhere (religious/political/social) to be mandatorily home quarantined for 05 days and tested as per protocol.

Health screening:

- Thermal screening will be conducted for all passengers Covid Test:
- Only passengers who are fully vaccinated, or Covid recovered, or with negative RTPCR report of last 72 hours shall be allowed entry in Punjab. In case a passenger doesn't have either of these, RAT testing shall be mandatory. Passengers travelling by flights shall be mandatorily required to be fully vaccinated, or Covid recovered, or with negative RTPCR report of last 72 hrs.

Passenger obligation:

- Only passengers who are fully vaccinated, or Covid recovered, or with negative RTPCR report of last 72 hours shall be allowed entry in Punjab. In case a passenger doesn't have either of these, RAT testing shall be mandatory. Passengers travelling by flights shall be mandatorily required to be fully vaccinated, or Covid recovered, or with negative RTPCR report of last 72 hrs.
- All passenger must register on COVA Punjab App before commencing their Journey
- Passengers are expected to certify the status of their health through the Arogya Setu mobile app or a Self Declaration Form.
- Boarding pass shall be considered as e-pass for movement to & from airport during curfew period

Airline obligation:

• Only passengers who are fully vaccinated, or Covid recovered, or with negative RTPCR report of last 72 hours shall be allowed entry in Punjab. In case a passenger doesn't have

either of these, RAT testing shall be mandatory. Passengers travelling by flights shall be mandatorily required to be fully vaccinated, or Covid recovered, or with negative RTPCR report of last 72 hrs.

- Provide details of passengers with state administration
- Deplane passengers from the aircraft by maintaining social distancing

Airport or State obligation:

- Only passengers who are fully vaccinated, or Covid recovered, or with negative RTPCR report of last 72 hours shall be allowed entry in Punjab. In case a passenger doesn't have either of these, RAT testing shall be mandatory. Passengers travelling by flights shall be mandatorily required to be fully vaccinated, or Covid recovered, or with negative RTPCR report of last 72 hrs.
- Thermal screening will be conducted for all passengers
- COVA Punjab and ArogyaSetu App registration to be checked for each passenger
